



The Maryland Port Administration is closely monitoring a potentially severe winter storm that is forecast to engage our area beginning Friday evening and possibly through early Sunday morning. The safety of the men and women who work at the Port of Baltimore is our top priority. We are already underway with storm preparations that include:

Coordinating vessel arrivals and preparing for possible delayed berthing of ships due to the weather;

Mobilizing snow team personnel who will work 12-hour shifts beginning Friday night;

Preparing snow removal equipment for the plowing and salting of the marine terminals.

We will keep you updated throughout this storm event on any changes to general Port of Baltimore public marine terminal operations through this e-broadcast messaging.
