Hurricane Season Begins June 1.

Experts Predict “Active to Extremely Active” Hurricane Season.

Officials, based on initial evaluations, are predicting 14 to 23 named storms in the Atlantic, eight to 14 of which could be hurricanes. Three to seven of these hurricanes could be major storms, rating Category 3 or higher.

In preparation for the 2010 Hurricane Season, please be reminded that it is time to review your Hurricane Preparedness Plan for your facilities and operations.
